ROBERT Abela has reshuffled his Cabinet eleven months into his premiership, and it is clear that COVID-19 has cost his ministers their portfolios, and in one case, his job.

Sivio Parnis is out, losing his parliamentary secretariat for the elderly after an outbreak of coronavirus inside homes for the

elderly raised questions on his ability to marshal a strategy to protect elderly patients.

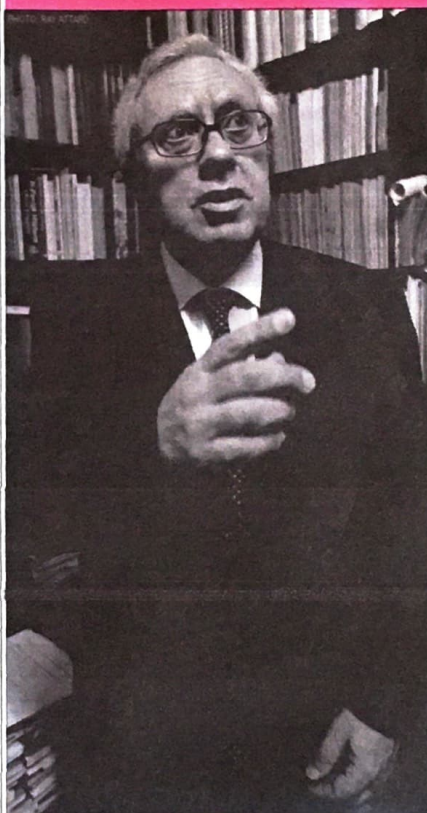
Owen Bonnici is effectively demoted 'sideways', losing the education portfolio after delays in school opening procedures due to coronavirus protocols, and instead is made minister of a new research and innovation ministry. However, this ministry will still be tasked to harness a post-COVID-19 strategy.

And Julia Farrugia Portelli also takes the fall after a summer opening many blamed for a spike in COVID-19 cases, with her tourism portfolio passed on to former junior minister Clayton Bartolo.

Farrugia Portelli is now minister for inclusion and quality of life, with parliamentary secretary Clifton Grima within her ministry, responsible for sports, recreation and NGOs.

Air Malta accounts still unpublished as new State aid bid beckons

AIR Malta has refrained from publishing its accounts for the financial year ending 2019, with over seven months elapsing since the national airline's annual appointment with the press.

The national airline usually publishes its annual figures in April. In February 2020, MaltaToday had revealed that Air Malta's journey to sustainable finances had once again been hampered by a year in which operational losses had climbed to €30 million.

But that was the figure right before the COVID-19 pandemic shut down the international travel industry, grounding all airplanes, and contributing to well over €100 million in losses for the beleaguered airline.

'He taught me to disobey'

OLIVER Friggieri, the man whose work laid bare the soul of a troubled nation in its worst days of political divide, has died. He was 73. His death was announced by his son on Saturday, 21 November.

An intellectual who was a poet, novelist, literary critic, and minor philosopher, his work had an unmistakable timbre of existentialism.

He articulated Malta's national consciousness in his works, notably with his 1986 work *Fil-Parlament ma Jikbrux Fjuri* and the unforgettable paean to murder victims Karin Grech and Raymond Caruana, victims of Malta's political war in the 1980s.

Friggieri was born in Floriana, Malta, in 1947. He studied at the Bishop's Seminary and then at the University of Malta in 1968 where he acquired a Bachelor of Arts in Maltese, Italian and Philosophy (1968), and then a Masters (1975).

In 1978 he acquired a Doctorate in Maltese literature and Literary Criticism from the Catholic University of Milan, Italy.

Friggieri began his career in 1968 teaching Maltese and Philosophy in secondary schools. In 1976, he started lecturing Maltese at the University of Malta, before being appointed head of department in 1988. He became Professor in 1990.

Between 1970 and 1971 Friggieri was active in Malta's literary revival movement, the Moviment Qawmien Letterarju. He was on the editorial board of the literary periodical *Il-Polz* (1969-73) and co-founded children's magazine *Is-Sagħtar* (1971).

In 1971 he collaborated in the establishment of the publishing house Klabb Kotba Maltin.

A Member of the Association Internationale des Critiques Littéraires of Paris, in 2008 Friggieri published his autobiography, *Fjuri li ma jinxfix*. In 2016, Friggieri was awarded the Gieh l-Akkademja tal-Malti gold medal.

Friggieri is the author of several books

and significantly contributed essays on Peter Caxaro and Mikiel Anton Vassalli. They include *Stejjer Għal Qabel Jidlam* (1986), *Fil-Gżira Taparsi Jikbru l-Fjuri* (1990), and novels *Il-Gidba* (1977), *L-Is-tramb* (1980), *Fil-Parlament ma Jikbrux Fjuri* (1986), *Gizimin li Qatt ma Jiftah* (1998), *It-Tfal Jigu bil-Vapuri* (2000) and others.

He said that as a young man, he got hold of a pamphlet in which Olivier Friggieri had written that an unjust law had to be broken. "It shocked me. We were taught at school to obey, so how could this poet tell me not to obey? I thank God for having taken his advice. I chose to disobey from that moment on and what I have done in my life is also fruit of the seed

The TV presenter Peppi Azzopardi, speaking to MaltaToday, called him "the man who taught me to disobey".

that Friggieri sowed in me."

Azzopardi said Friggieri was a "poet in Parliament, the village square, the university, the dockyard and the factory."

"His poems were not self-gratifying or a showcase of his own deep thoughts; he did not write poems so that school children could learn their meter and rhyme. He wrote a poetry that was understood by the people without a critic interceding for him."

"Friggieri was a man of caution but he could sow courage and overcome fear in the name of what was right. It was the right thing not to make him President of the Republic, for his poems would have

caused him trouble. His work keeps him alive, speaking to all our consciences."

The writer and academic Prof. Adrian Grima, said Friggieri had almost single-handedly established Maltese literary theory and criticism as an academic discipline.

"We owe our work in this field to him. Even today his academic writings remain fundamentally important to all those who want to write about our literature."

"But he was also scrupulously aware of his role and his responsibility both as a leading public intellectual and as an educator. Students and many others found solace in his profound humanity, in his quiet manners, in his ability to empathise with people and share their sorrow. To me, and to many others, he was a second father. I will miss him dearly."

Accolades from leaders

The Maltese government saluted Friggieri's memory. "He is one of Malta's greatest writers, whose recognition goes beyond Maltese shores. He is a patriot who celebrated Maltese identity, and whose work is a reference point for the language, contributing much to Maltese history, and promoting a sense of unity for this nation."

Accolades for the writer came from Nationalist Party leader Bernard Grech, who saluted the "giant of Maltese literature, a prolific writer whose workers were translated in various languages... he bequeathed unto us a long career to the benefit of the Maltese language."

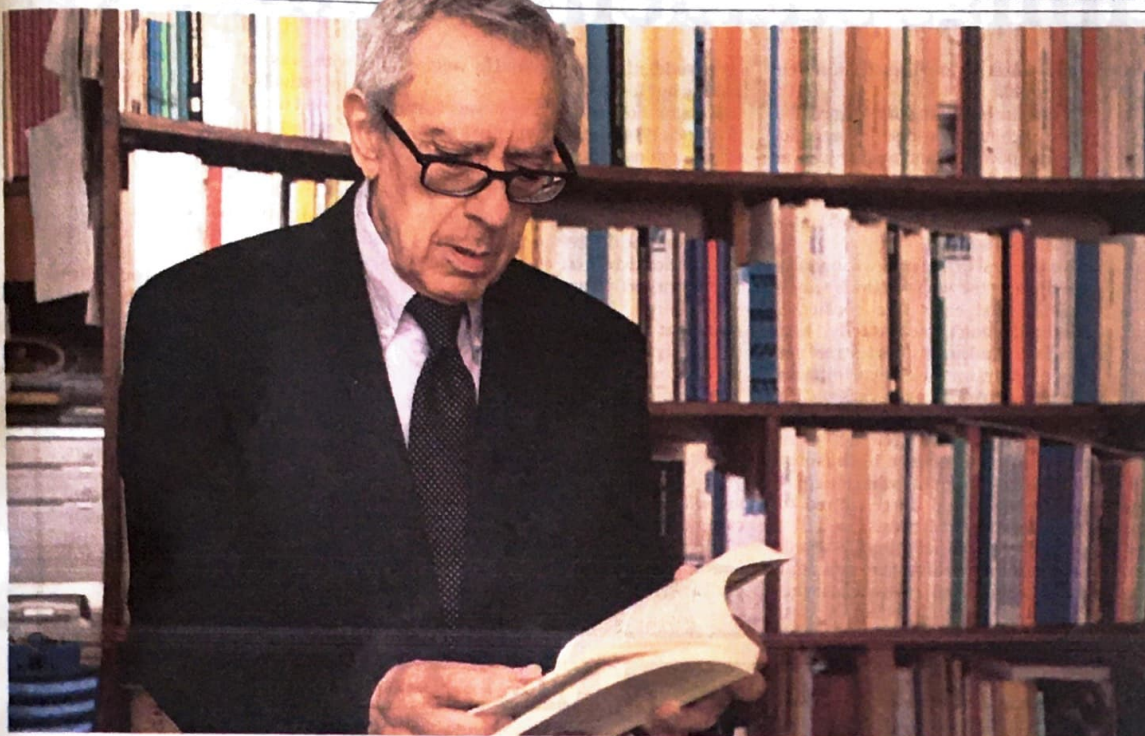
Former prime minister Joseph Muscat described Friggieri as a "genuine friend".

"His authenticity did not recognise political affiliation, and he would call out what was good and bad in all our country's phases. His works were a symbol of the Fenech Adami 'resistance' in the 1980s. But he was also someone who recognised the good that Mintoff did. He was one of the persons whose small chats with me influenced me in my time in politics."

Most people plan to stay home this Christmas

Christmas looks set to take on a different spirit this year, with the majority of people planning to stay home in the midst of the pandemic, according to a Times of Malta survey.

As COVID-19 continues to spread, the health authorities have been asking for sacrifices to be made over the Christmas period, asking people to limit their contacts with those outside their households.

And it looks like many are taking the message seriously. Just over half the respondents to a survey (53 per cent) said they would be celebrating Christmas at home alone or with their partner.

However, 37 per cent still intend to spend it with family and friends, while six per cent are unsure and the rest will do other activities, according to the survey carried out by advisory firm EMCS.

As the economic impact of the pandemic continues to bite, over a third (38 per cent) intend to spend less money than usual this Christmas.

On the other hand, spending patterns for 60 per cent of respondents will remain unchanged compared to last year.

Two per cent want to splurge more than they usually do over the holiday season.

Polidano has €40m tax bill

Construction magnate's lawyers have begun to contest dues

Construction tycoon Charles Polidano has been ordered to settle more than €40 million in tax dues or face possible court action.

Times of Malta is informed that Polidano, known as Ic-Ċaġnu, has over the past few days been served with a number of court

documents ordering him to pay a massive tax bill, some of which stretches back to the 1990s. The company is one of the leading construction firms in Malta, regularly involved in major national infrastructure projects.

Polidano, 60, one of the wealthiest men on the island, has racked up €30.4 million in unpaid taxes on his flagship company Polidano Brothers Limited. It also has another two smaller tax bills of €6.3 million

and €1.2 million, which have also long been outstanding, sources said.

The court orders, known as judicial acts, were filed by the Inland Revenue Commissioner in the first week of November.

Tax department sources said that Polidano had previously entered into a number of payment plans with onerous obligations

Oliver Friggieri dead at 73

Tributes poured in for Oliver Friggieri, described as one of Malta's greatest ever writers, after he died yesterday aged 73.

His death was announced by his family on Facebook.

Friggieri, also an educator, philosopher and literary critic, was pivotal in promoting Maltese literature and the use of the Maltese language.

He was among the co-founders of popular children's magazine *Is-Sagħtar*, as well as local publishing house *Klabb Kotba Maltin*.

Friggieri taught Maltese in secondary schools before moving on to tertiary education. He was appointed head of the University of Malta's Department of Maltese in 1988 and continued to lead the department until 2002.

He published a wide variety of books, ranging from works of literary criticism to poetry, as well as 10 novels and a collection of sketches. His works have been translated into English, French, German, Italian and Greek.

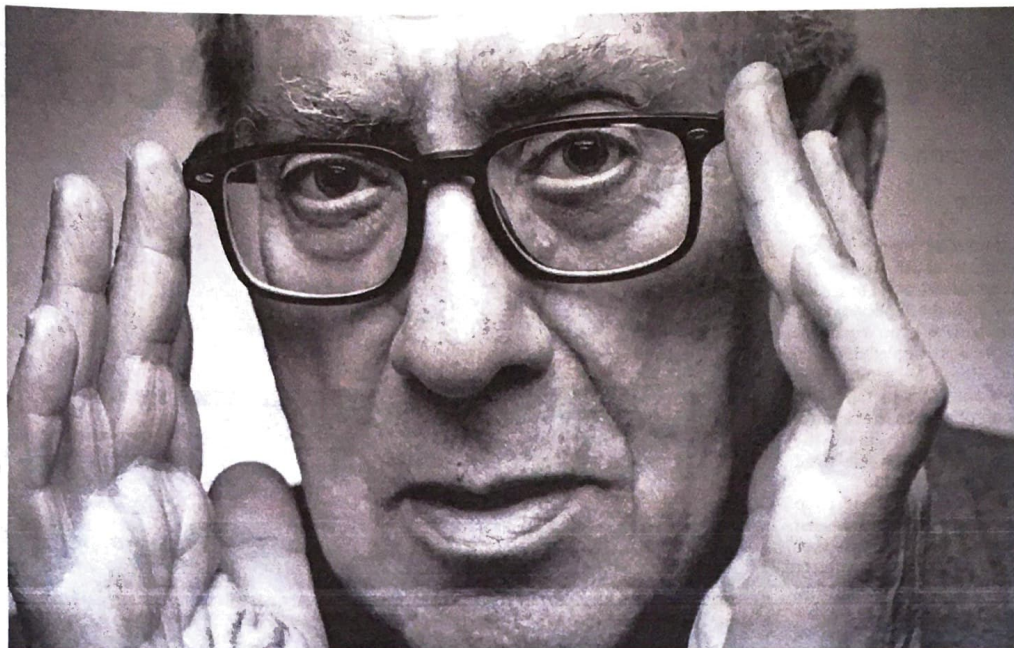
Among his most famous works was his 1986 novel *Fil-Parlament ma jikbrux Fjuri*, which sparked controversy for its frank depiction of political tribalism within Malta.

Friggieri was honoured with a gold medal in the *Gieh l-Akkademja tal-Malti* in 2016 and won various editions of the National Book Prize.

In one of his last interviews, published by *Times of Malta* last June, he mused on the COVID-19 pandemic.

"It all provides an unprecedented lesson in humility. The universe is theocentric and not homocentric," he had said.

In a statement, the government paid tribute to Friggieri as "one of this country's

greatest ever writers" and said his writing had helped foster a sense of national unity.

"His love for the arts, research and philosophy inspired one generation after the other," the statement noted.

Both the Labour and Nationalist parties also issued statements paying tribute and offering his family their condolences.

Friggieri had been instrumental in establishing the PN's newspapers *In-Nazzjon* and *Il-Mument*.

On social media he was described as a man who had instilled a strong love for the Maltese language in many.

Archbishop Charles Scicluna was among the first to pay a "heartfelt" tribute. Friggieri, he said, "taught us to love the Maltese language and be proud of our literary heritage."

The news shocked fellow author Alfred Sant, a former prime minister, who

had known Friggieri since the mid-1960s. He said one of Friggieri's best qualities, apart from the arts, culture and education, was a "profound sense of tolerance".

Friggieri's friend and fellow poet Daniel Massa will remember him as "working tirelessly" all his life for the cause of Maltese literature and all that is Maltese.

"Your numerous brilliant works will remain a beacon, lighting up the way for a younger generation of writers," he said, upon learning of his passing away.

Friggieri's former student, fellow writer and colleague Gorg Mallia penned a poetic tribute, accompanied by a portrait of his mentor.

"He was the man we emulated when we tried to understand the depths in the cavernous maws of literature... he gave

us the method, he built the way with his incredible mind. The university's Faculty of Arts said the country had lost an icon: "A life has come to an end, but what a life fulfilled! What better epitaph than one from a poem by the master he spent so much of his life studying: *Non Omnis Moriar*".

President George Vella described him as a "staunch promoter of the Maltese language and identity".

Prime Minister Robert Abela described Friggieri as a man of great humanity and humility.

"Above all, he was a man who dearly loved Malta, its people and language."

PN leader Bernard Grech referred to Friggieri as a giant of literature.

"The literary work that Friggieri has left us, and his efforts in favour of the Maltese language, are his best heritage."

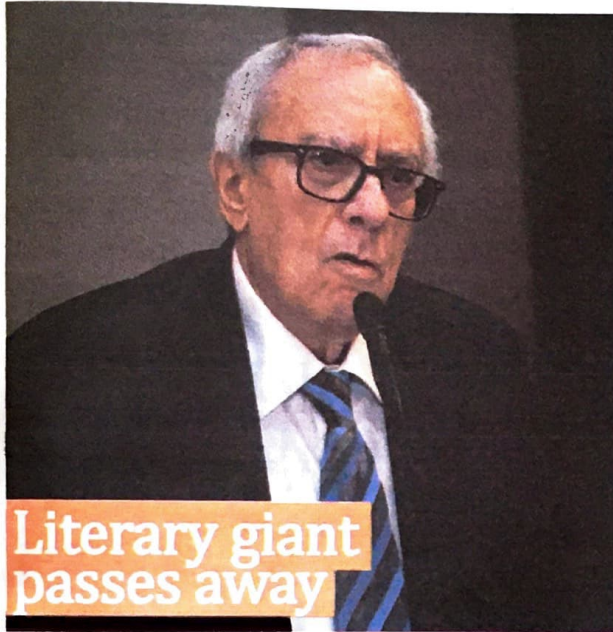

Literary giant passes away

Writer Oliver Friggieri has died aged 73. Friggieri is considered a giant in the field, having taught Maltese and won numerous local and international literary prizes over the years. He was secretary of the Moviment Qawmien Letterarju and also a co-founder of the Klabb Kotba Maltin. He lectured at the University of Malta, where he was nominated associate professor and became head of the Department of Maltese in 1988 and full professor in 1990. He has contributed many critical works dealing with literary theory, critical studies, stylistic analysis and literary biographies. Some of his works were translated into foreign languages. He has also published several poetry books, short stories and other literature, among which "Fil-Parlament ma jikbrux fjuri".

"My electoral mandate stays, and I will remain true to it," newly elected First Vice President of the European Parliament (EP) Roberta Metsola said during an interview with *The Malta Independent on Sunday*. After being nominated for the post by the European People's

Party (EPP), which she forms part of, Metsola was elected as the First Vice President for the EP two weeks ago with a unanimous vote across all political parties, replacing Mairead McGuinness who became European Commissioner. The position is the second-highest position in the whole EP, after the President, and there are 13 other Vice Presidents who deal with dif-

ferent matters. She is the first Maltese MEP to become Vice President. *The Malta Independent on Sunday* interviewed Metsola, who described what her role entails, how she will represent Malta, as well as her opinion on migration and the Moneyval evaluation, among other topics.

Bernard Grech should have contested 12th district, not 11th – PN insiders

Nationalist Party Leader Bernard Grech should have contested the 12th, not 11th, electoral district, as the PN is risking losing it to Labour, party insiders told *The Malta Independent on Sunday*.

A few days ago, the PN executive committee approved the candidacy of Grech for the fifth and 11th districts. Grech will be leading the PN in an election for the first time, having beaten incumbent Adrian Delia in a leadership election held in October.

But whereas the choice of the fifth district is seen as an attempt from the party to attract voters from the south, the selec-

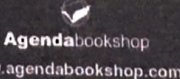
tion of the 11th district has been received with scepticism.

The PN is weak on the fifth district, part of the Labour-dominated south of Malta, and the presence of the leader on the ballot sheet is aimed to serve as a boost. In 2017, the PN elected Toni Bezzina and Hermann Schiavone, the latter making it to Parliament without obtaining a quota.

Given the 4-1 defeats in the second, third and fourth electoral districts, the 3-2 loss in the fifth was a half-miracle for the PN, with the last PL candidate Stefan Zrinzo Azzopardi losing out to Schiavone by fewer than 400 votes in the last count. Zrinzo Azzopardi was subsequently elected in a casual election.

Kien l-ewwel student li ggrawda MA (1975) fil-letteratura Maltija u aktar tard kiseb ukoll il-grad ta' Ph.D. (1978) b'teżijiet ta' kritika komparata – *La Cultura Italiana del Romanticismo e la Poesia Maltese* (1978).

Huwa kien kofundatur tal-Movement Qawmien Letterarju, u għamel żmien l-edittur ta' *Il-Polz* (1969-1973) – ir-rivista tal-Movement. Kien ukoll kofundatur tar-rivista *Sagħtar* u hażem mill-qrib ma' Pawlu Mizzi biex twaqqaf il-Klabb Kotba Maltin fl-1971.

Beda l-karriera tiegħu bħala għalliem fl-iskejjel sekondarji fejn għalliem il-Malti u l-Filosofija (1968-75) u aktar tard inhatar lektur fid-Dipartiment tal-Malti fl-Università ta' Malta (1976-90). Kien Kap tad-Dipartiment tal-Malti, kariga li żamm mill-1988 sal-2002 u Professur tal-Letteratura mill-1990. Kien editur ta' *Journal of Maltese Studies* (1980).

Ittraduċa xogħlijiet mil-Latin, mit-Taljan u mill-Ingliż, fosthom *De Arte Poetica* ta' Orazju, *Hrejjef għat-Tfal* ta' Grimm u Andersen u *Il-Hanut tal-Argentier* ta' Karol Woytyla.

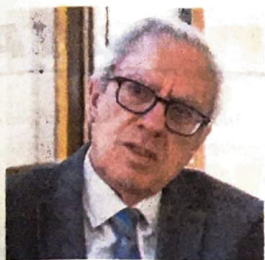

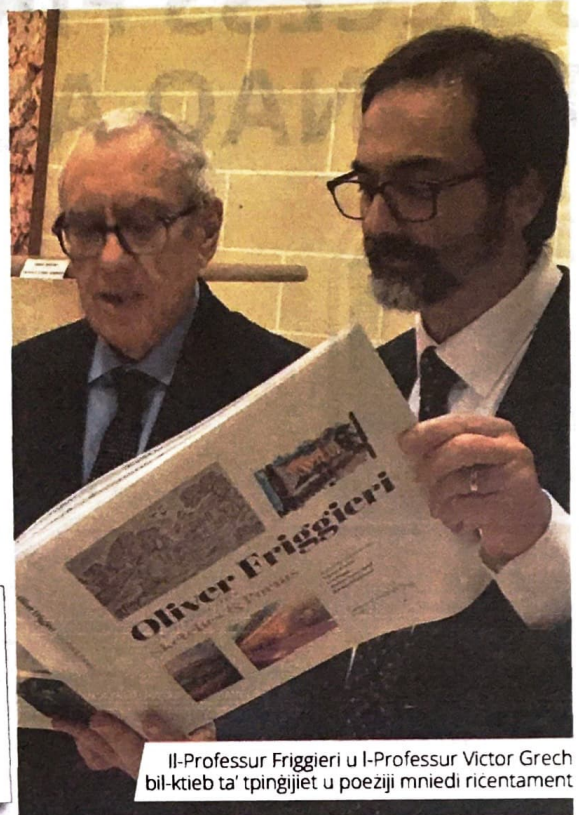

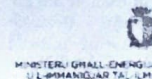
